What is the project about?

At the beginning of the COVID-19 outbreak, it soon became clear that crisis policy was often implemented at national level. Existing networks were more or less overruled. Discoordination caused numerous bottlenecks in the border regions, which proved detrimental to Euroregional co-operation. PANDEMRIC, aimed at promoting Euroregional cooperation in the field of health care, may offer opportunities for optimal cross-border crisis management.

Work Package 1

The aim of this WP is to translate national/federal policies into euregional policies in the border region EMR by making use of the possibilities of a euregional approach to the Covid crisis.

Work Package 2

The aim of WP 2 is to support Work Package 1 regarding Euregional Outbreak management by developing web-based tools.

Work Package 3

The aim of this WP is to learn from the first COVID-19 outbreak via research, to strengthen Euregional cooperation in the field of such major long-term crises and to explore possibilities to improve the delivery of assistance to citizens by conducting scientific studies.



Work Package 4

The aim of this WP is to foster the cooperation when it comes to the use of materials, infrastructure and capacity. The Work Package focuses on supplies, the supply chain as well as the test/lab capacity.
